DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Medical Services Division (MSD) is responsible for pre-employment and occupational health screening for candidates and City employees. MSD also provides medical services to three City detention centers. The successful candidate for Relief Nurse will perform professional nursing services within the Medical Services Division including Occupational Health and Correctional Care in assisting physicians in the medical evaluation and treatment of employees, candidates, arrestees and prisoners in City jails. May act as lead nurse on an individual shift; and does related work.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A valid Registered Nurse License issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing; and
- 2. Current valid American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR card.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applications are subject to review and only the most qualified candidates will be invited to an interview and writing exercise.
