## Emergency Medical Services Educator (2322) Task List

- 1. Prepares and presents classroom lectures on emergency medical services subjects to ensure Department members are in compliance with State and Los Angeles County continuing education requirements.
- Conducts post-incident case analyses for use in trainings by reviewing records such as electronic patient care reports (ePCR), EMS 911 recordings, and the Los Angeles County EMS Agency Pre-Hospital Care Policy Manual to ensure proper patient treatment is provided in accordance with LAFD policies and State and local protocols.
- 3. Reviews Fire Department EMS forms (e.g., Department notices, training bulletins) in order to ensure practical application of pre-hospital care modalities.
- 4. Researches current State and local pre-hospital care literature in order to update awareness, identify trends, and to develop lesson plans for Department members.
- 5. Prepares, maintains, and orders necessary supplies, equipment and instruction materials in order to instruct classroom training.
- 6. Provides and tracks continuing education by scheduling classes and monitoring members' attendance and completed hours to ensure compliance with State and local mandated requirements.
- 7. Represents the Fire Department at meetings and conferences relative to pre-hospital care continuing education.
- 8. Prepares and administers exams (e.g., written exams, skills tests) in order for members to demonstrate proficiency and/or achieve continuing education certification units.
